Park News - New Nature Center Update

Nature Center Complex Timeline

Fall 2021 – Winter 2022: Pre-Game Plan

At the end of February 2022, the Planning, Preservation, and Design (PPD) Team completed pre-planning meetings that involved the Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Team and the White Clay Creek Park Staff. The importance of these preliminary meetings, which included some site visits, was to discuss the needs and wants of the park staff, ideas for the complex, and understand realities of what is feasible.

Spring 2022 – Summer 2022: Show me the Money

With the pre-planning done and all teams understanding a general idea of what needs to be done, the PPD Team geared up for the new fiscal budget (new fiscal year starts July 1) and how much funding the Nature Center complex would be allocated. The Nature Center and some bridge work was allocated \$4.5 million. The intent is to go straight from planning stages through to construction.

The PPD Team has a meeting scheduled with a contractor, GWWO, for mid-August to discuss the pre-planning needs and wants list and to "get the ball rolling".

Fall 2022 - ???: Game Plan

A construction timeline cannot be estimated at this time but will become clearer after the preliminary meetings with GWWO.
