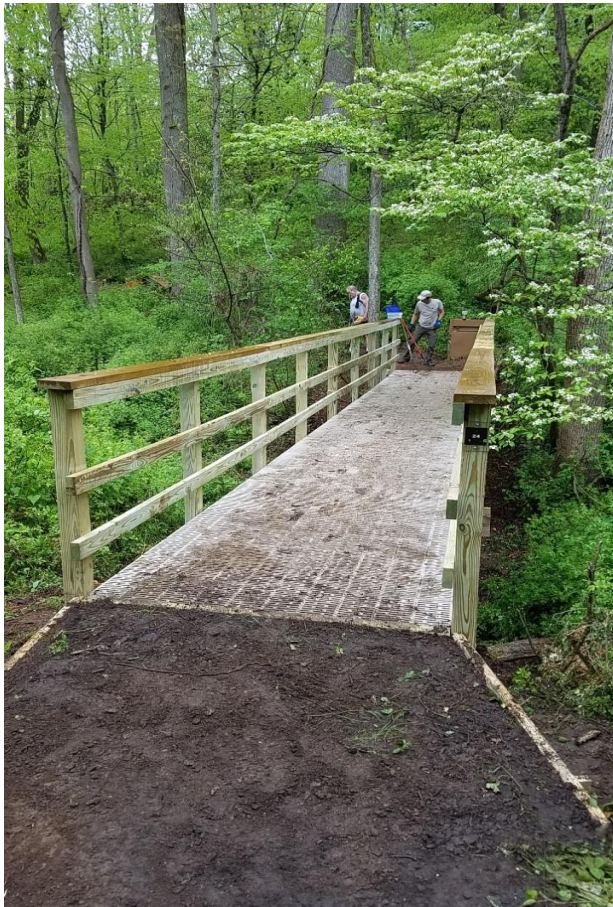


Volunteer Activities
